

The 100 yard Range will be open to the general public to hunters to sight-in their rifles. There will be Range Officers there to help and supervise all shooting. If it gets canceled due to rain or bad roads the next day will be open. Please come out. Sight-in that rifle that has not been shot in months and get ready for a wonderful and successful hunt this year. Bring your Guns, ammo, spotting scope and most of all your hunting clothes.

Sight-in Tips

Use a large target, start a 25 yards, adjust for wind. Take 3 shoots from bench, adjust, take 3 more shots repeat if needed. If good move to 100 yards and start all over. If one inch low at 25 yards should be right on at 100 yards. Now, shoot as if hunting, standing, sitting or laying down using the same procedure. (Shoot 3 more times) until satisfied you can hit your target at the anticipated distances. Go hunting and bring back a good time.
