



Greetings Club Member,

The Old Fort Gun Club annual membership renewal for 2026 is now in-progress. As with the past two years, members will either receive a reminder by email or hard copy via USPS. Membership forms are revised annually due to processing changes, so please ensure you are completing the 2026 revision.

The following list includes several updates and changes implemented during 2025.

- **On-site Credit Cards:** Credit and debit cards are now accepted for *in-person only* transactions. A \$5.00 fee will be added to the total to cover bank processing fees.
- **On-site Badge Printing:** New members will now receive their official badges at the monthly meeting. This eliminates the need to issue temporary cards.
- **Youth Badges discontinued:** Youths under age 18 must be accompanied by an adult with a membership badge and don't need to wear badges. Youths 18-20 not accompanied by a member will need to be listed with birth date on the renewal form to receive their youth badge.
- **Range Improvements:** A new berm was made for the 50-yd targets on the 100-yd bay, a shooting deck was added on the 300-yd and lights have been installed on bay 14. Twelve concrete benches were installed on the 100-yd range to support the new ARA match.

Please be patient while we work through changes to improve our process and introduce new services. Returning your renewal to us promptly will ensure your badges are received for the mid-February gate change. Please note the following points and updates with the renewal process:

1. **Renewal & Credit:** Complete the renewal form and ensure your information is legible. Attach any range maintenance credit slips for work performed on scheduled range workdays, match set-up or tear-down. If you did not receive a credit slip, contact the proper Match Director prior to renewing.
2. **Submission & Badge Return :** You can submit your renewal by mail to the address at the top of the renewal form, use the registration building's yellow drop box or at the monthly meeting. Depending on when we receive your renewal, badges will be available for pick up at the next monthly meeting. Any badges not picked up will be mailed the next day. You may also bring your renewal to the meeting and wait for badges to be printed along with the new memberships.
Renewals rec'd in Dec can be picked up at the Jan 1st meeting. Renewals rec'd in Jan, pickup Feb 5th.
3. **Deadline:** Renewals must be received by the February 5th monthly meeting. If not, you will need to complete a New Membership Application to be reinstated.
