

When: 3rd Saturday of each month


Time: 9:00 am Match (Summer) 10:00 am (Nov - Mar)

Trap shooting "PULL"

Trap is shot from 5 positions in a crescent-shape, 16 or more yards behind the trap. Shooter #1 loads ONE shell and yells "pull." A target is launched and #1 shoots. Next, #2 loads a shell and when ready yells "pull." Shooting continues until each shooter has fired 5 shots from that position. Each shooter then rotates one position to the right. Shooting continues until each shooter has fired 5 shots from each position.

Open to all Youth 8-17 years to come out to try our Shooting sports Events will use:

.22 LR rifles in many forms, single shot, semiautomatic, bolt action, lever action. 22 LR pistols in semiautomatic and revolvers. 20 gauge shotguns also 410 and 12 gauge in many forms.

To shoot in these events the youth must be accompanied by an adult and attend the firearm safety training course before the shooting part of the event.

There is no charge for any of these events and the targets, ammo, and firearms are furnished by the OFGC.

You do not have to be a member of OFGC for the youth to participate. They will be supervised at each shooting station.

Small bore/Pistol Cartridge (SB/PC) & Full Scale (FS) Silhouette Shooting

The Matches consist of 40 rounds being shot at 10 metallic targets at 4 different distances for a total of 40 targets.

Chickens at 40 meters (SB/PC) & 50 meters (FS), Pigs at 50 meters (SB/PC) & 100 meters (FS), Turkeys at 75 meters (SB/PC) & 150 meters (FS) and Rams at 100 Meters (SB/PC) & 200 meters (FS). Any targets being knocked off the stand is counted as a hit (SB/PC) or just being hit using swinging targets (FS).



When: 1st Saturday (SB/PC) & 2nd Saturday (FS) of each month.
Time: 9:00am for Setup and Practice, 10am Match Start Time.
Where: River Range—100-yard range (SB/PC) & 300-yard range (FS).
Cost: \$5 per match, per gun, per shooter.

What you will need:

Small Bore (SB): .22LR Tube fed, **NON-Bolt** Action (Ex. Lever Action, Semi-Auto, Pump), Open Sight rifle.

Pistol Cartridge (PC): .22 Magnum and up, Tube fed, Lever Action, Open Sight rifle. Straight Walled Pistol Cartridge (with a few exceptions).

Full Scale (FS): Rifle Cartridge, Tube fed, Lever Action, Open Sight rifle. (Ex. 30-30 type rifle). Capable of knocking over a 55 lb. Ram Target.

Any ammo causing target damage will be forbidden.

NRA FTR/F open, Hi-Power Rifle & Military Service Rifle Matches

NRA FTR, F Open, and High Power matches are three courses that are shot at 300 yards at a 600 yard simulated Target with of twenty rounds each course.

NRA Service Rifle Match consists of 4 courses of fire, with 10 rounds from a standing position at 200 yards, then kneeling or sitting 10 rounds with a magazine change also from 200 yards. Followed by 10 rounds from 300 yards from a prone position. Finally, from a prone position (300 yards from target) a simulated 600 yard in which 20 minutes is allowed to fire 20 rounds.

When: 4th Saturday of each month

Time: 8:00 am FTR, F Open and High Power
11:00 am Service Rifle Match

Where: River Range - 300 yard range

Cost: Club match: \$ 10.00, NRA Sanctioned match: \$ 20.00

What you will need:

Service rifle any former military service rifle.

FTR must be .223 or .308 with bi-pod.

F open is unlimited caliber and any rest may be used.
